

SUPPLIES

Each student is expected to have:

- 1) **Tennis Shoes for Physical Education.** These should be left at school at all times. If it is necessary to take them home for special reasons, they should be cleaned before returning. This is to assure the utmost of cleanliness of the gymnasium floors.
- 2) **Student Name or Initials on:**
 - a. BOTH tennis shoes.
 - b. BOTH boots.
 - c. BOTH mittens.
 - d. Caps, coats, etc.
 - e. Personal belongings such as tablets, books, etc.
- 3) Backpacks need to fit in lockers (some are small) and should not have wheels.
- 4) Headphones (no earbuds) that will be used in future grades
- 5) Students should bring the following supplies to school at the beginning of the school year (**and replace as needed throughout the school year**):

Kindergarten:

- Rug or towel for rest time. (No mats)
- Tennis shoes for Phy. Ed. **(Must have all year long)**
- 1 box of 16 small crayons
- 2 bottles of white Elmer's glue (4 oz.)
- 2 Dry Erase Markers - low odor and no red please
- 1 Box of Kleenex
- 1 box of Crayola markers (10 count)
- 1 plastic pencil box – no tins
- 12 pencils – preferably Ticonderoga brand
- 2 Plastic Pocket folders
- 1 Primary composition notebook
- 1 primary journal notebook – blank on top with lines on bottom.
- 1 Back Pack - (no wheels)
- Scissors (Fiskars School)
- 4 Glue sticks
- Headphones (no earbuds) that will be used in future grades



Grade 1:

- 12 pencils
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- Tennis shoes for **Phy. Ed. (Must have all year long)**
- Large box of Kleenex (for classroom use)
- 2 bottles of white Elmer's glue
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 pocket folder **(no Trapper Keepers)**
- Erasers
- Pencil box
- 3 black dry erase markers (low odor)
- Scissors (Fiskars School)
- 2 wide-lined Primary composition notebook
- Headphones, not earbuds



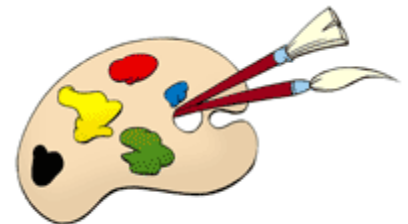
Grade 2:

- Headphones, not earbuds
- 12 pencils
- Scissors
- 1 eraser (soft type) and 1 pack of pencil top erasers (5)
- 1 box of color crayons (at least 16 to a box)
- 1 wide line spiral bound notebooks (8"x10")
- Tennis shoes **for Phy. Ed. (Must have all year long)**
- Big box of Kleenex (200 count)
- 1 bottle of white Elmer's glue (4 oz.) (not gel)
- 3 heavy-weight plastic pocket folders (**no Trapper Keepers**)
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 4 Dry Erase Markers (low odor in black or blue preferred)
- 1 box markers
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 Wide-Lined composition notebook
- **Field Trips:** Swift County Museum, Sibley State Park, Country School, Halloween Bowling (Approx. \$3.00 total for all field trips - payable when they go on the trip)



2nd Grade - Mrs. Carroll's Looping Class

- 12 pencils
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 box of markers
- 2 composition notebooks (wide-lined)
- 1 box of Kleenex
- tennis shoes (Phy ed)
- 3 plastic folders with pockets
- 1 bottle Elmer's glue
- 1 plastic pencil case
- Headphones, not earbuds

Grade 3:

- Headphones, not earbuds
- 12 pencils and pencil top erasers
- 1 box of color crayons (at least 24 is all that is needed))
- Colored Markers
- Loose-leaf paper – 150 sheets
- 1 wide-lined composition notebook
- Tennis shoes **for Phy. Ed. (Must have all year long)**
- 3 pocket folders (Heavyweight plastic - **no Trapper Keepers**)
- Large box of Kleenex (for classroom use)
- 1 bottle white Elmer's glue (4 oz.)
- Scissors (**sharp pointed**)
- 4 dry erase markers – odorless
- 1 plastic pencil box
- **Field Trips:** Theatre Performance, Environmental Trip.
Trip cost is payable when students go on the trip.

3rd Grade - Mrs. Duncan's Looping Class

- New plastic folder--most students have 2 left from this year
- 4 black dry erase markers--Expo low odor please! It really does make a difference!
- 12 pencils--We find that "Ticonderoga" are the best pencils. Many others just break when sharpened and the fancy pencils are difficult to sharpen as well.
- 1 wide lined spiral notebook
- Large box of Kleenex - We went through a lot this year!
- Tennis shoes for PE
- Headphones if your child doesn't have a pair at school yet. We are leaving this at school for next year.

Grade 4:

- Headphones, not earbuds
- 24 pencils
- Pencil top erasers (soft type)
- 1 box of markers
- **Tennis shoes for Phy. Ed.-Must have all year long in locker**
- Big box of Facial Tissue
- 1 pencil box
- 3 pocket folders
- Composition notebook
- 1 Container of Clorox Wipes
- **Field Trips:** Andes Ski Trip (approx. \$15.00). Trip cost is payable when students go on the trip.

Grade 5:

- Headphones, not earbuds
- 6 #2 pencils - If you choose mechanical pencils, have a tube of extra lead
- 2 folders
- 1 Composition Notebook (9.75" x 7.5")
- A 2nd notebook of your choice
- Tennis shoes **for Phy. Ed.**
- A family-sized box of tissues
- A bottle of hand sanitizer Or container of disinfecting wipes
- 1 ream of white copier paper
- No Trapper Keepers or Five Star Zippered Keepers or 3-ring binders as they do not fit in our desk.



Grade 6:

- Headphones, not earbuds
- 3 pencils
- 1 eraser (soft type)
- 3 ring notebook (**not spirals**)
- Tennis shoes for **Phy. Ed.**
- 6 portfolio pocket folders

**No Trapper Keepers or Five Star Zippered Keepers.
They do not fit in our desks.**
