All BHS Seniors who are planning to attend post-secondary education (full-time – Fall 2025) are encouraged to complete the scholarship application packet. Approximately 60 scholarships with a total value of more than \$50,000 are available (in varying amounts) and will be awarded to eligible applicants who have completed the application process.

<u>ONLINE APPLICATION FORMS</u>: Please review the criteria for each scholarship listed in this packet. The 2024-2025 BHS Centennial of Education Scholarship Application Form may be found on the District website at www.benson.kl2.mn.us under Schools, Benson High School, Counselor's Corner. Download and save the BHS Scholarship Application to your own directory before beginning.

You may apply for as many of the scholarships as you qualify for, but remember that a **separate** application form and letter of application is needed for each one. In your letter, include the reasons you believe you are a good candidate to be awarded the scholarship, and how you meet the scholarship guidelines.

On the application form, please check the box in front of the name of the scholarship for which you are applying, and staple this form to the front of the corresponding application. The correct GPA to be recorded on your application form is the 9-12 "Cumulative GPA" found on your transcript. (Do not use "year GPA" or "term GPA". Incorrect GPA's are crossed out on your application and corrected.) If you have questions about GPA, please talk to Jason Strand.

You must get any information needed from the counselor's office prior to the March 17 deadline.

<u>USE OF REFERENCES</u>: Applications ask for names of references. Reference letters are not required for the BHS scholarships, but these people may be contacted in the selection process. Please procure permission before listing anyone as a reference. If letters of recommendation are required with any of your applications, common courtesy would be to assure ample time for those from whom you have requested these letters.

<u>PAYMENT</u>: Unless otherwise stated, payment will be made to the student next winter, after verification of completion of the first term of the student's postsecondary freshman year is received. Watch for this Verification Voucher to come to your parents' address mid-November. Full time enrollment is required.

All Scholarships will be awarded at a Scholarship Ceremony on <u>Monday May 12, 2025.</u>

CRITERIA: Awarded to a graduating BHS student/athlete who demonstrates exceptional leadership in the classroom and on the field of athletic competition. REQUIREMENTS: Special Application required and letter to the Scholarship Committee explaining involvement in athletics at BHS and how that involvement has helped to better prepare you for the future. Checks will be issued by the Mills Memorial Scholarship Fund.

It is preferred that the student has a high school work history, is from a single-parent household, and is pursuing a Registered Nursing Degree. REQUIREMENTS: Complete Megan Pothen Graham Memorial Scholarship Application. Applicant's financial need will also be considered for this scholarship.

Ray Millett Memorial Scholarship - \$1000

CRITERIA: Awarded to a graduating senior accepted to a college or technical college, who has demonstrated leadership qualities in school and in the community with preference given to a senior planning to pursue a career in the Electrical or related field. REQUIREMENTS: Special Application required and a letter of application to the Scholarship Committee.

Swift County Corn & Soybean Growers Association – Two Scholarships - \$1,000 each

CRITERIA: Awarded to a graduating senior pursuing a future in agriculture or a related field and is planning to enroll in two, three, or four-year post-secondary education. Applicants must be a resident of Swift County and their parents must be members of the MN Corn Growers or MN Soybean Growers Association. REQUIREMENTS: Special Application required.

Tom Petersen Memorial Scholarship - \$500

CRITERIA: Awarded to a graduating senior accepted to any public college or technical college. Based upon economic need and work history (preference given to single-parent households). REQUIREMENTS: Special Application required and letter to the Scholarship Committee explaining need and work history.

Edgar Coryell, Clara Coryell, Grace Walls & Richard Walls Memorial Scholarships (Two \$2500 Scholarships to be awarded; one boy/one girl.) <www.communitygiving.org>

CRITERIA: Awarded to one senior boy and one senior girl, who are accepted to an accredited college, university or technical college. Applicants must have maintained at least a 3.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale). Eligible applicants are high school seniors attending BHS and must live within a ten-mile radius of the city limits of Benson, and should be permanent residents of the State of Minnesota. Applicants must demonstrate financial need, and through involvement in extra-curricular school activities and participation, show a recognizable contribution to Benson High School, as well as to community values and service. The likelihood of succeeding in college or trade school will also be a determining factor. Scholarships are not renewable. REQUIREMENTS: Special Application required, two letters of recommendation, and letter to the Scholarship Committee addressing criteria.

Edgar & Clara Coryell spent the majority of their married life in Benson. Clara was a teacher and the couple instilled the value of education in their three daughters, Grace Coryell-Walls, Edith Coryell-Erdman, and Alice Coryell Lee Nelson. All three graduated from Benson High School and went on to become teachers. Grace Coryell-Walls and her husband Richard Walls were generous in the disposition of their estates, establishing endowed scholarships in both of their hometowns named for their respective parents and themselves, perhaps as a legacy for the children that they never had. The Edgar Coryell, Clara Coryell, Grace Walls and Richard Walls Scholarship Fund annually awards two \$2000 Scholarships, to one boy and one girl who is a member of that year's graduating class.

<u>Application and Selection Procedures:</u> Completed Application Forms will be reviewed and evaluated by the Benson High School Scholarship Advisory Committee who will recommend scholarship applicants to the Community Foundation's Board of Directors. The Board will then approve or disapprove the Committee's recommendations.

<u>Coryell-Walls Applicant Responsibilities:</u> Applicants are responsible for completing the application form, writing and submitting the essay/statement, and submitting a copy of their most recent high school transcript. If the applicant has transferred high schools, those transcripts should also be submitted. If the student has selected a college or institution to attend, the college or technical financial aid officer is responsible, at the student's request, to fill out the appropriate sections. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. A complete scholarship application contains the following:

- 1. A scholarship application form filled out completely by the student, and signed by the financial aid officer of the college/university/vocational/trade school which the student has selected to attend.
- 2. A personal statement answering the seven questions on the attached sheet, describing the student's career and educational goals. <u>This statement should not exceed two typewritten, double-spaced pages</u>. The statement is very important in the selection process.
- 3. Two reference letters commenting on the applicant's strengths and weaknesses, student's motivation to achieve, and leadership experience.
- 4. Current transcript from Benson High School showing a "B" average or better.
- 5. The completed scholarship application must be returned to the Benson High School Counseling Office by March, 11, 2024. Notice that the Financial Aid Office of the College you have selected to attend must sign off with your financial needs analysis, based on your FAFSA/EFC and their cost estimates. Do not wait until the last week to secure this information as this process may take a little time. Make sure your FAFSA is completed ASAP.

Check the Counselor's Corner on the BHS website periodically for new scholarship postings which are not part of the Centennial of Education Scholarship program. Churches, insurance companies, banks, credit unions, civic organizations, parent work places and the colleges to which you have applied may have additional scholarship opportunities you may be eligible for.
